Concerning educational attainment, 23.1% of the selected regions' residents possess a Bachelor's Degree (4.5% above the national average), and 6.8% hold an Associate's Degree (1.2% below the national average).

The top three industries in 2018 are Restaurants and Other Eating Places, Education and Hospitals (Local Government), and Federal Government, Civilian.












